call for project

eligibility criteria

The chosen project must engage one of the fields of intervention of the Endowment Fund, which are:

- Ill or handicapped children
- Social and vocational integration for youth
- Children in difficult social or familial situations
- Victims of humanitarian crises and conflicts

The project organisers will benefit, at the most, of 2 supports during the period 2018-2021.

To be eligible for support by Paris Saint-Germain Children First, the project must:

- be undertaken by a non-profit organisation of public utility or community interest, eligible for donations, as established in Article 238-A of the CGI, and capable of issuing tax receipts.
- not be undertaken by a religious, confessional or political organisation.
- be exclusively dedicated to helping children and/or youths and include them in active participation.
- offer not only financial support, but also support and accompany the children and youths on a human level and also within the fields of influence of Paris Saint-Germain Children First. Paris Saint-Germain Children First privileges active sponsorship and will focus efforts on a small number of projects to ensure complete support and assist the project's organisation.
- be managed with impartiality.



Children first

quality criteria

To be eligible for support by Paris Saint-Germain Children First, the project must meet the following quality criteria

- Relevance of the project:

The project addresses a clearly identified problem and is in phase with the objectives of the Endowment Fund.

- Quality of the plan of action:

The project is precise, well-structured and realistic and presents clearly defined objectives and potential results.

- Identification and involvement of beneficiaries:

The project must help children and youths in need.

- Project monitoring and evaluation:

Strict and regular progress reports, evaluation of results, and ability to publish and promote progress.

- Capacity to organise a project:

The project organisers must show their experience and/or competences in the project's fields of intervention, as well as its capacity (technical, operational, financial...) to see the project to fruition.

- Realistic budget and financial package:

The provisional budget must be consistent with the plan of action. The financial package and plan must be realistic, and mention other potential or engaged financial partners as well as the planned part of self-financing. The Endowment Fund contribution must be equal or less than the contributions of other financial partners associated to the project.



criteria for exclusion

Paris Saint-Germain Children First will not finance:

- Sponsoring requests
- Organisations for profit
- Individual or student projects
- Political or religious initiatives
- Projects that do not meet the eligibility and quality criteria explained above



monitoring and final project report

The project organisers must be able to measure the social impact of the project via clearly identified and measurable indicators and also propose a follow-up annual report of said social impact.

- Every project organisation supported by the Endowment Fund must respect the monitoring and final project report procedure established by the Endowment Fund in order to follow the progress of the project, monitor the use of funding and to measure the results of each project.
- The successful project organisations are expected to send at least one annual activity report and one financial statement.
- The Endowment Fund reserves the right to visit each of the projects it supports.
